
Map of Lebanon representing the Youth Hostels sites

The main aim of these centers is to provide peace and opportunity for ecotourism encouraging local production. The food is mainly from the area, prepared by women of the village and all fruits and vegetables are the products of the village itself. Smoking is forbidden inside the center.

Worldwide passport

he Youth hostel concept is not new in Lebanon. The Lebanese youth hostels federation was established in 1964 and became a member of the International Youth Hostels Federation in 1966. It currently has seventy members. Young Lebanese have the possibility to join the LYHF (LBP 20.000 per year) Their membership card allows them access to above 5000 foreign hostels. It is truly a world wide passport.

History:

he Youth Hostel movement was founded in Germany since 1909.

The idea began with the German schoolteacher





Richard Schirmann, who arranged for students of limited means visits to the countryside and cities of the world. The idea soon spread across Europe with a series of youth hostels associations being set up in different countries. In 1932 the international youth hostels federation was founded.

Its mission is "to promote the education of all young people of all nations, especially young people of limited means, by encouraging in them a greater knowledge, love and care of the countryside and appreciation of the cultural values of towns and cities in all parts of the world, and to provide hostels or other accommodation in which there is no distinctions of race, nationality, color, religion, sex, class, or political opinions and thereby to develop a better understanding of their fellow men, both at home and abroad.

The Lebanese Youth Hostels Federation was founded in 1965. The youth hostels are situated in great locations across Lebanon just waiting to welcome you by offering a comfortable bed, a warm shower, and a fully equiped kitchen to fullfill your needs and ensure you enjoy the freedom of nature.

1. Eco. Club - Becharreh

he Committee for Conservation of the Environment (Eco-Club) of Becharreh is a non-profit organization dedicated to improve environmental conditions of the region in North Lebanon which is considered to be one of the most important ecological rich location in the Middle East. The region includes touristic and cultural sites such as: Kornet el-Sawda, the Cedars Forest, summer and winter resort



with trekking. In ancient time Lebanon was covered by the Cedars of God and its precious timber was used for temple construction such as the Salomon's Temple. Four km from Becharre we can discover Bquaakafra, the native village of St. Charbel. The Quadisha valley, classified as World Patrimonial Site by UNESCO and the Jibran Khalil Jibran Museum (Lebanese poet and painter).

At 7 km from there we can visit the Diman, summer residence of the Maronite Patriarch.

Several ecological projects concerning the conservation of nature have been achieved, namely: the protection of the parklands and reforestation and projects for sorting and recycling the garbage.

eity's association founded in 2004, this project is a result of a trip around the world "45 country" realized by Josephine Zgheib (president of beity) carrying a peace message, Josephine's intention in her trip was to accept others and live with their differences in their societies. Beity, (my home), it's a unique experience. The Challenge..., The International Friendship..., The Adventure..., the spirit..., Beity exists in the biggest village in Lebanon "Kfardebian" located between 900m and 2800m above sea level. Its



population is estimated at 12000 inhabitants. It is located at as far as 44 km from Beirut. The village is inhabited in winter as in summer considering the activities of the ski resorts of Fakra and Ouyoun Es Siman, the best one in Lebanon and the Middle East. In summer, the region is turned into a resort and leisure center accessed by the coast line inhabitants. Renown for its agricultural produces, and its fragrant honey, Kfardebian is rich in water. Phoenician and roman ruins of Fakra and wonderful natural bridge make Kfardebian historical village. To access the village, take Beirut- Jounieh highway, and turn right past Nahr el-kaleb, in the direction of Keserwan Mountains, where Kfardebian is located.

4 Saint Georges Convent - Bherdok

Saint Georges Convent Bherdok was founded in 1605. It is located at 20km from the coastal Beirut on a hilltop overlooking the coastal area of Antelias in the heart of a scenic pine forest. It represents a key environment heritage site due to its biodiversity significance with regard to the whole neighbourhood. The location is characterized by local traditions and handicrafts practices in a rural landscape rich in cultural diversity and archaeological sites, such as Beit-Chabab village known for bells and pottery production especially large jars for olive oil and arak, Chaouyeh, village which is the hometown of



philosopher-writer Amine Rihani, el-Fraykeh, village encompassing a museum of the philosopher Amine Rihani, and a center of traditional rural practices like pine nuts production.
